of CISM Parachuting Committee (CPC) enlarged meeting (Policy, 3.11 B.)

time: Wednesday 21st of July 2010, 19:30 – 20:30

1. **Welcome**

President of CPC, Col DERMINE, welcomed all present Chiefs of Mission, Team Leaders, Judges, Competitors and other Parachuting Experts.

3. Preparation of future **Championships**

World Military Parachuting Championships:

2011: 5th MWG and 36th WMPC in RESENDE, BRAZIL

Possible organizer for 2012 and later:

Participants are requested to report back to their CISM Delegation and Defence Forces and ask for support of parachuting as a military sport by organising future WMPC or other Parachuting events

4. Amendments to current **rules**:

Reminder (since 2009):

One cameraman with military status has to be provided, she/he is member of the team and will get a medal

CISM Policy Manual Art 3.19

All military participants in a CISM event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active military service of the member nation he represents. The documentation can be:

1. a valid military identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad,
2. a form of verification (in English and/or French) of military status accompanied by a passport

In autumn 2010 the official rules for 2011 (valid from 01Jan11) will be ready for download at the CISM website <http://www.cism-milsport.org>

A draft version will be included in the CD/DVD of the 35th WMPC and will be sent to CPC mailing list (see 6. contact addresses)

For 36th WMPC (MWG) special rules will be posted on CISM website too (Style?)

Changes were made on following subjects:

◆ § 3.3.1. Composition of Mission:

Team coach will be added to the list of possible members in the mission, so the maximum will be 15 (+ CPC member if any):

- Chief of Mission
- Judge
- Teamleader
- NEW: Coach (if not same person as Teamleader)
- 5+5 competitors (+ cameraman if not one of the above)

BUT: Special rules for MWG 2011 are based on current regulations!

No Chief of Mission for the disciplines, coach not valid yet => max. 13 persons.

Official nomination of extra members to MWG will cost 300\$/ day according to MWG invitation file, which was distributed to all CISM member nations. If Parachuting teams plans to bring any additional member of the delegation, contact Col Edgard Lantelme 36wmpc.rio2011@gmail.com

◆ § 5.3.1. Accuracy

Scoring for landing off the AMD (on control pad) will be 17, on artificial pit - matress outside the control pad 18 and for landing outside the mat and maximum score will be 19.

◆ § 7.1.1. Definitions Formation Skydive (clarification only)

- no change of divepool for 2011
but changes for edition 2012 will be decided next year for the 2012 edition

5. Judges:

- CISM will continue with current judges rules and all judges have to do an evaluation every 2nd year

- All participating nations have to nominate a qualified judge on the preliminary entry form (for next year it will be in January 2011 !) A CISM international or FAI category 1 license in two disciplines is needed for being qualified for a WMPC (FAI list is at www.fai.org/parachuting/judges and CISM list is at <http://www.cism-milsport.org>

The delegation, not the organizer or CPC, is responsible and the “no judge no team” rule will apply! Exceptions may be granted by the President of CPC (e.g. if a country only practices one event.)

The judge may be civilian and also come from another country, CPC can provide contact addresses if assistance in finding a judge is needed and nations without a qualified judge are encouraged to contact judges asap (e.g. during this competition).
