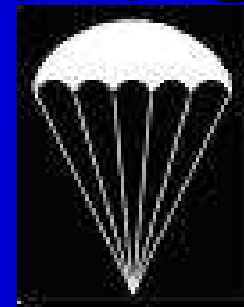

rules (1)

General:

- Reminder (since 2009):
One cameraman with military status has to be provided, she/he is member of the team and will get a medal

CISM Policy Manual Art 3.19

All military participants in a CISM event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active military service of the member nation he represents. The documentation can be:

- 1. a valid military identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad,*
- 2. a form of verification (in English and/or French) of military status accompanied by a passport*

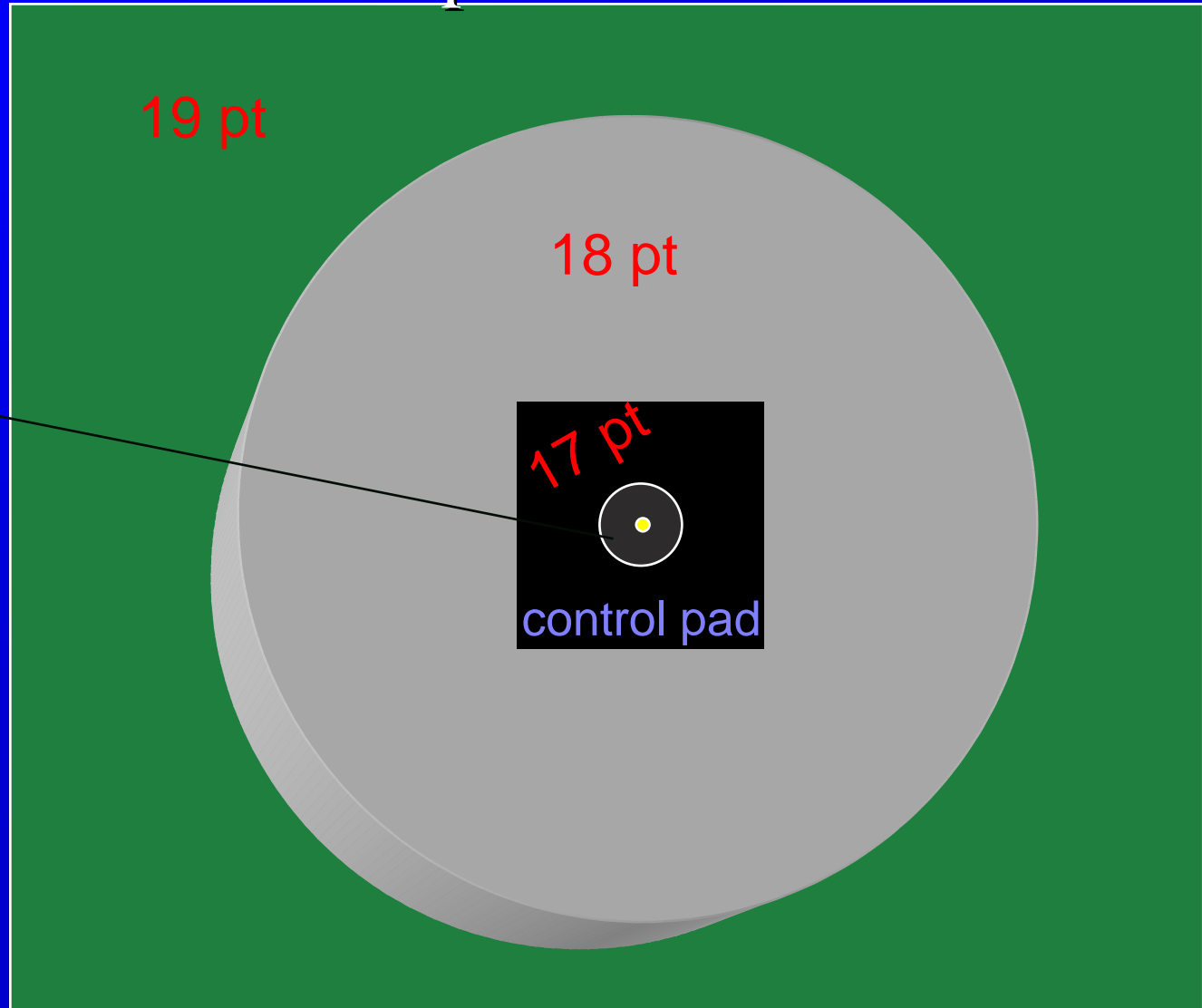
changes on Parachuting rules

- Change in Composition of Mission:
 - Team coach will be added to the list of possible members in the mission, so the maximum is 15 (+ CPC member if any):
 - Chief of Mission
 - Judge
 - Teamleader
 - Coach (if not same person as Teamleader)
 - 5+5 competitors (+ cameraman if not one of the above)
- BUT: Special rules for MWG 2011 are based on current regulations!
 - No Chief of Mission for the disciplines => max. 13
 - Official nomination of extra members to MWG = 300\$/ day
 - Procedure for additional members in the delegation will be briefed by delegates from BRAZIL.

Judges (old slide)

CISM will continue with current judges rules and all judges have to pass an evaluation every 2nd year

all nations have to nominate an **international qualified and valid** judge at **preliminary** entry form, i.e. three months prior to the competition.

The delegation, not the organizer or CPC is responsible!

“no judge no team” rule will apply!

CPC can provide contact addresses if assistance in finding a judge is needed.

Judging in CISM



Philosophy of judging in CISM

- Rules give some freedom to CJ/EJ in order to use common sense
- Competitors/teams shall be penalized if they could get any advantage in performing in an unclear/wrong way
- Main goal for judges panel is to provide a correct score for all competitors (e.g. rejudging/ rejump,...)
